Summer Camp Is Upon Us ...and So Is the Registration Deadline!!!

Adult Camp Deadline is May 15th.

Deadline for All Children and Youth Camps is May 30th. (Registrations received between May 31st and June 6th will carry a \$45 late charge...so register on time.)

And remember, our church pays half scholarships for all children, youth and young adults who wish to attend camp.

(So, for the week-long youth camps, the church pays \$215 of the full registration fee of \$430...and we also pay half the amount for all children attending Grandparents and Me and all young adults attending Young Adult/Adult Camp)

Please let the church office know when you register online, so we will know to send the regional church the half scholarship for your camper.

Summer Camps at CGC

Summer camps begin in less than one month with Young Adult/Adult Camp beginning on May 31st. That is a camp for everyone who is over 18 and at least one year out of high school. Here are the dates for all the camps and a bit of information about each one:

- Young Adult/Adult Camp is May 31st through June 3rd. Tina Heck is the director of Adult Camp and the keynoter will be Steve Borgard, pastor of Lafayette Christian Church. He will address the theme of the compassion of Jesus.
- Junior Camp is June 24-30 (graduates of 3rd thru 5th grades).

 Melissa Paulucci and Kathy Schales are co-directors, Bentley Stewart is once again the keynoter, and Larry Love will be the chaplain.
- Chi Rho Camp is also June 24-30 (graduates of 6th thru 8th grades). Ted Firch and Alicia Stolp are the directors and Monica Cross is the Keynoter. Larry Love will be chaplain.
- CYF Camp is the week of July 1-7 (graduates of 9th thru 12th grades). Haley (Corbett) Monachello will be one of the directors, and Bentley Stewart is the keynoter.
- Grandparents and Me is June 30th to July 2nd (entering K thru 3rd grades). Christy Newton is the director.

The theme for the camp is "BTW...What's a Christian" and deals with what it means to be a Christian. Our campers will experience shared living on "Holy Ground". From examples of how Jesus lived a life of faith we also hope to continue our lifelong faith journeys and more deeply become "Disciples of Christ". This curriculum invites campers to explore the question "What is a Christian?" The Disciples of Christ theology centers on three key touchstones: Baptism, Table, Word. Throughout the week, campers will learn more about loving God and loving each other through exploring how their beliefs and behaviors connect to Disciples' understanding of Baptism (belonging to and being accepted by a faith community), the invitation to the Table (the act of communion), and the power of the Word through scripture (and their own words).

Cost for camp is:

\$430 for Junior Camp, Chi Rho Camp, CYF Camp.

Grandparents and Me Camp varies depending on accommodations—\$60 for children and up to \$130 for the grandparents (or other adults) who accompany them.

Young Adult/Adult Camp also varies depending on accommodations—\$140 for your own tent, \$200 for a shared cabin (with bunk beds), and \$265 for Claar House rooms.

Remember, the church pays half-scholarships for all children and youth and young adults wanting to attend camp!!!

<u>Registration is available online at ccncn.org.</u> Young Adult/Adult Camp registrations are due May 15th, and registration for all other camps is due <u>May 30th</u>. Registrations received between May 31st and June 6th will require a late fee of \$45. <u>If you have any questions about the online</u> registration, please contact Pastor Larry Love.
