General Assembly

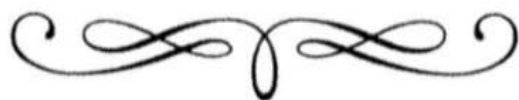
The General Assembly of the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) meets in Indianapolis, Indiana July 8-12, 2017.

In addition to great worship services and preaching, the General Assembly will vote on a new General Minister-President. The candidate is the Rev. Terri Hord Owens.

There is also a full schedule of workshops and learning tracks to stimulate thinking about the life and ministry of the church. A large exhibition hall offers opportunities to talk with representatives of scores of different ministries offered by the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ)...as well as a large bookstore. Larry and Nancy Love and Sue Tarleton are attending and would welcome other church members to join them. Registration fee is \$190 plus hotel (\$109-\$139 per night) and airfare.
